REPORT OF TOWN OFFICIALS

SUPERVISOR

- The monthly bank statements were presented for review by the Board.
- A work session will be held in June for the Solar Law. Gary Abraham will charge \$2,000.00, same as the Wind Farm Law.
- The 1st quarter sales tax for 2021 was \$104,981.78. This was up \$19,084.51 from 2020 1st quarter amount.
- A Local Law on Bonding of Roads is needed for the Solar and Wind Farm projects to cover roads as it is not covered under the Wind or Solar Laws. Supervisor Parker will talk to the attorney and get information for the Board.

SUPERINTENDENT OF HIGHWAYS

- National Fuel hookup for Godfrey Road and David Drive- Each household and the Highway Garage will pay approximately \$5,200.00 to hook up to the gas line. This can be paid in full or over a ten year period. National Fuel is waiting for all residents to respond.
- The F250 (2013) truck went to auction and sold for \$9,600.00.
- The Zipper was used on some small streets. All will get sealed.
- The Bridge NY Grant will get submitted tomorrow (May 19, 2021). The cost to do the grant was \$2,900.00
- The town will be receiving \$176,000 for CHIPS money in June.


